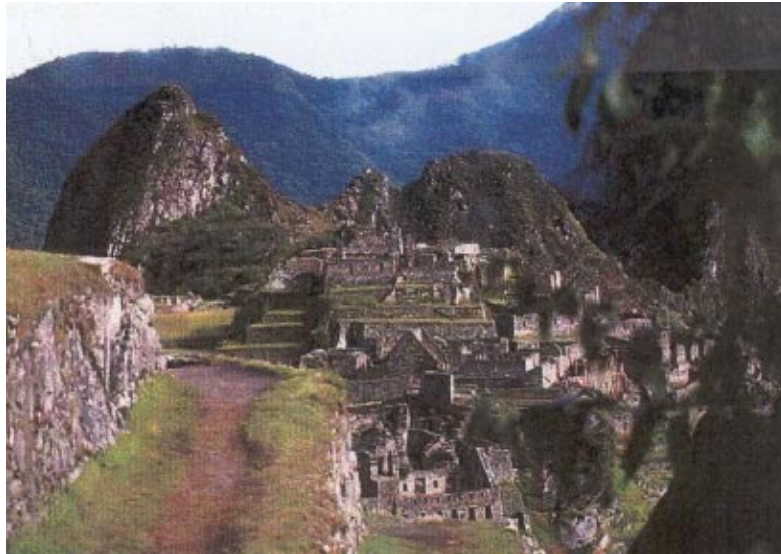

Sunday, June 30

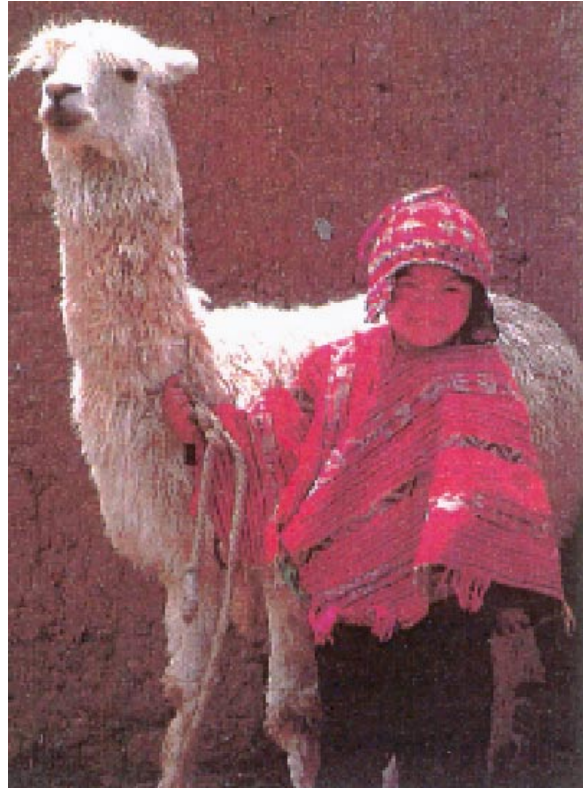
Cuzco, Pisac, Sacred Valley Early morning departure from Cuzco to Pisac to explore the market and archaeological site.

Monday, July 8

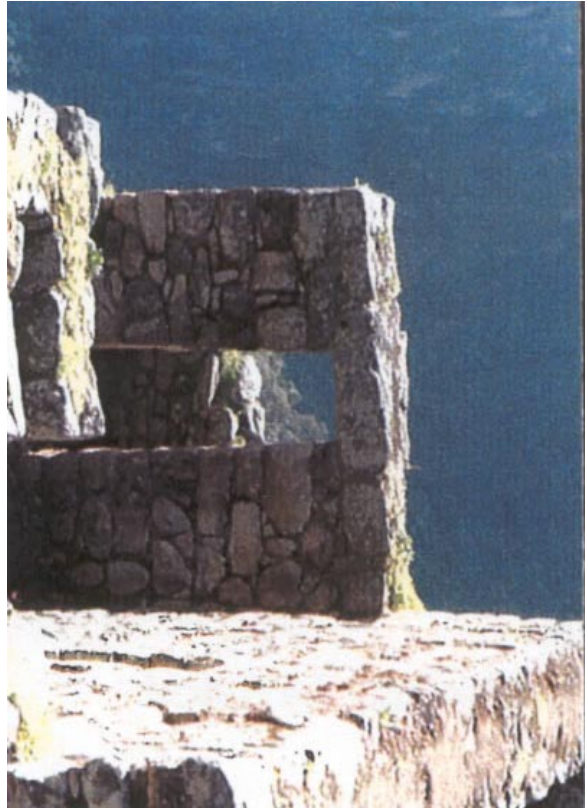
Lake Titicaca Early morning departure by boat; tour of Uros Floating Islands; arrive at the island of Taquile. Cultural anthropology, shamanism

Details:

Leave 'n Learn trip to Peru 2002

This 12 day trip includes:

- Ground transportation to and from Lima airport
- All national flights and taxes, transfers, tours, entrance fees, hotels, guides, and meals as noted
- Most meals
- 20 hours of **¡Español Rápido!** Spanish course focusing on vocabulary relative to travel and Peruvian culture
- All class materials
- Native ceremonies
- Final fiesta with native food and music, certificates

Not included:

- Airfare to Lima
- Alcoholic beverages and personal shopping
- Meals not covered (see flier)

Hotels:

All hotels are moderate to high quality. The exception is on the island of Taquile, where there is only one option. (Until recently it was impossible to stay on the island, so this will be quite a privilege.)

Cost:

- \$2500 (based on double occupancy)
- \$3500 (single occupancy)
- \$ 800 (children sharing a room with adults)

What to Bring:

Peru is high altitude which means that it can be warm during the day, cold at night. Pack layers of clothes. Also take sturdy walking shoes, a camera, cash (travelers checks are expensive and require a long wait; there are ATM machines), a money belt, Spanish-English dictionary, and, of course, your passport.

Travel:

We recommend that you make your travel arrangements with America's Travel in San Francisco (415 703.9955). Ask for Toni Moore. So far she has been able to arrange travel from almost anywhere in the U.S. to Lima for an amazing round trip fare of \$550.
